**WellnessLink Community Calendar allows community members and organizations across New Hampshire to post, view, and search for community events and activities in a centralized location accessible to the general public.**

**All events and activities must be open to the public and be specifically geared toward the aging population.** Intergenerational events and activities are acceptable. Community members and organizations are encouraged to provide ADA accommodations to make events and activities accessible and inclusive for all participants.

All events submitted to the WellnessLink Community Calendar are subject to public disclosure under applicable local, state, and/or Federal law. Partnership for Public Health reserves the right to restrict or remove any content that is deemed offensive, inflammatory, discriminatory, or inappropriate, or is a violation of this event calendar policy or any applicable law. Partnership for Public Health staff shall make the final determination as to whether to restrict or remove any content on the calendar. Posting an event on the WellnessLink Community Calendar does not guarantee attendance by members of the public, Partnership for Public Health staff, elected officials, or media personalities.

### **Acceptable Events**

Examples of events submitted to the WellnessLink Community Calendar include:

- Educational, social, health, wellness, cultural, or recreational events open to the public but specifically geared toward people aged 60+, including community events, fairs and celebrations; performing arts, concerts, shows, sporting events, support groups or drop-in discussions, and other community activities.
- Informational/educational seminars, clinics, workshops, or meetings.
- Support groups and other peer-support community discussion groups.

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### **Unacceptable Postings**

Events submitted for posting containing any of the following shall not be approved for posting:

- Events for children, teenagers, young adults or not appropriate for people over age 60.
- Profane language or content.
- Events that promote a specific religious or political activity or belief (e.g., church services, political fundraisers or rallies).
- Sexual content or links to sexual content.
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability or sexual orientation.
- Solicitations of commerce (e.g., yard sales, individual retail store offers, sale advertisements, individual fundraisers).
- K-12 or college events.
- Invite-only events and announcements.
- Conduct or encouragement of illegal activity.
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems.
- Content that violates a legal ownership interest of any other party.
